**ORDER**

Upon consideration of the government's *ex parte* Application for an Order Pursuant to the All Writs Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1651, precluding Uber Technologies, Inc. ("Uber") from disclosing the existence of a grand jury subpoena, and for the reasons stated therein and in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion filed under seal, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that Uber not disclose the existence of grand jury subpoena number GJ2017070640571 to any other person (except attorneys for Uber for the purpose of receiving legal advice) for a period of 180 days, unless otherwise ordered by the Court; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Application, this Order, and the accompanying Memorandum Opinion are sealed, except for the purpose of serving this Order on Uber, unless otherwise ordered by the Court; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the United States Attorney's Office shall, by July 21, 2017, review this Order and the accompanying Memorandum Opinion and propose any portions that may be partially unsealed for filing on the public docket.
