Moxila A. Upadhyaya Sworn in as United States Magistrate Judge

WASHINGTON, D.C. September 7, 2022. **Moxila A. Upadhyaya** was sworn in today to serve an eight-year term as Magistrate Judge, filling a newly authorized position on the Court. She will preside over civil and criminal matters in Courtroom 5 of the E. Barrett Prettyman United States Courthouse.

Until recently, Ms. Upadhyaya was a partner at Venable LLP, with a practice focused on complex civil litigation. Her substantial *pro bono* work included a successful petition for review under the D.C. Innocence Protection Act. Ms. Upadhyaya began her legal career as a law clerk to then-Chief Judge Eric T. Washington of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals. She later served as a law clerk to the Hon. Robert L. Wilkins during his tenure as a District Judge on this Court. Ms. Upadhyaya received a Bachelor of Arts degree, with honors in Latin, from the University of Missouri and a Bachelor of Journalism degree, *magna cum laude*, from the Missouri School of Journalism. She received her J.D., *cum laude*, from Washington College of Law at American University.

Ms. Upadhyaya was selected by the Court following a comprehensive selection process. The Court's Merit Selection Panel was chaired by Ana Reyes, Esq.
