**ORDERED** that lists of docket numbers, with some associated docket information, for **(A)** applications filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2703(d); **(B)** applications filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2703(a)–(c)(1)(A) and/or Rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure; **(C)** applications filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3512 ("Foreign requests for assistance in criminal investigations and prosecutions"); and **(D)** applications for pen registers and trap and trace devices ("PR/TT") filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3122 and 3123, set out in Attachments **A**, **B**, **C**, and **D**, respectively, which applications were filed by the USAO-DC between **April 1, 2019**

and September 30, 2019, shall be unsealed;<sup>1</sup> and it is further
